

- * Data as on 22nd August 2005
 - Most countries are polio free and Polio cases restricted to few countries only
 - India is doing very well, contributing to only 3-4% cases of Global load in 2005
 - Most States in India are polio free for variable periods
 - Intensified efforts are going on in high risk areas, for underserved community and for people in transit.

Surveillance

- Sensitive AFP Surveillance is an essential part of eradication strategy. Missing any case at this crucial juncture is not only detrimental to the programme but also misleading.
- Immediate Reporting of all Acute Flaccid Paralysis cases (syndromic approach) in less than 15 years is a must. (Cases with onset of paralysis upto 6 month back at any point of time to be reported)

All cases to be reported with detailed address and contact number irrespective of :-

- 1. Cases seen in OPD / Casualty / Wards / going LAMA
- 2. Clinical diagnosis of the case
- 3. Local or outstation patients
- 4. Patient coming directly to you or referred cases.

Any doubtful, border line case or under investigation case to be first reported without waiting for final diagnosis.
