KEM Hospital, Pune is a 650 bed multi-speciality tertiary care teaching hospital. The Department of Pediatrics has a state of the art NICU having 50 beds (1500 admissions/year), PICU 10 beds (700 admissions/year), General Pediatrics 70 beds (2500 admissions/year). The NICU/PICU has 25 ventilators including high frequency ventilation, high flow nasal cannula, portable 2D Echo, bedside EEG, TPN facilities, nitric oxide, whole body cooling etc. The Pediatric department also offers other specialised services like gastroenterology, genetics, nephrology, pediatric surgery, neurosurgery, trauma, child rehabilitation, etc. We also offer specialty fellowship courses (Post MD/DNB) in Pediatric Nephrology and Pediatric Gastroenterology.

The Department is recognised for DNB General Paediatrics for the last 30 years, DNB Neonatology for last 10 years, DNB (Ped Nephrology) for last two years, PICU (College of Pediatric Critical Care) and NICU fellowships (IAP and NNF) for last 10 years.
