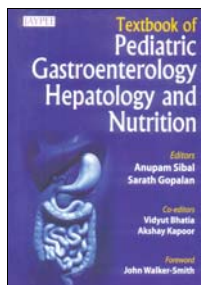

Textbook of Pediatric Gastroenterology Hepatology and Nutrition

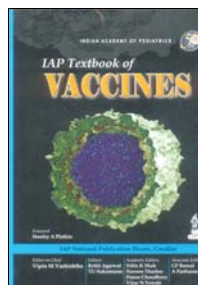

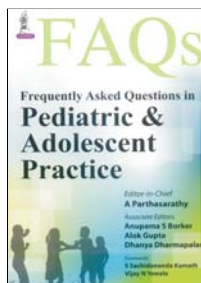
